



Specialty pharmacy network

Specialty drugs come in many forms such as pills, liquids, injections (shots), infusions, or inhalers. They may need special storage and handling. If you're taking a medicine that is considered a specialty drug, you may need to use a specialty pharmacy for your drug to be covered. In-network specialty pharmacies are listed below.

Typically, specialty drugs that are self-administered will be covered under the pharmacy benefit. Specialty drugs that are administered to you in your provider's office are typically covered under your medical benefit. If you use out-of-network pharmacies, your medicine may not be covered. You may have to pay the full cost if you use a pharmacy that is not in the network. For more details about your coverage, you can call the phone number on your member ID card.
