Updated *Clinical Practice Guidelines* are now available on the website. These evidence-based guidelines were reviewed and approved by our quality improvement committee. The guidelines include direct links to the source documents for reference.

Updates in the 2024 version include:

- Updates to links and dates published in existing guidelines as needed.
- Addition of guidelines:
 - *Atopic Dermatitis: Clinical Guideline* by the American Academy of Dermatology, last updated in 2023
 - *Eosinophilic Esophagitis: 2020 Clinical Guideline* by the American Gastroenterological Association
 - *First-Episode Psychosis and Schizophrenia: 2023 guideline development* by the Veterans Administration/Department of Defense
 - *Rhinitis: 2020 practice parameter update* by the American Academy of Allergy, Asthma, and Immunology
 - *Drug-Resistant Tuberculosis: 2019 Clinical Practice Guideline* developed by multiple entities including the American Thoracic Society, the CDC, and the Infectious Diseases Society of America
 - *Pediatric Anxiety: 2020 Clinical Practice Guideline* by the American Academy of Pediatrics. Addresses children and adolescents
 - *Perinatal Depression: Policy statement* by the American Academy of Pediatrics
- Replacements of guidelines:
 - *Alzheimer's Disease: Resource site* aimed at health systems and medical professionals replaces 2014 guideline by the American Psychiatric Association.
 - *Sickle Cell Disease: 2020 guideline* by the American Society of Hematology replaces a 2014 expert panel report by the National Heart, Lung, Blood Institute.
